The Crucible Essay Assignment

Choose <u>one</u> of the following topics to write a 4-paragraph paper in MLA Format. Use at least 2 quotes from the play to support your thesis. Set these quotes up in MLA format (you will get more information on this.) ALL work on the essay will be done in class.

1. Is John Proctor a "good" man? John has made some big (HUGE!) mistakes, but at the end of the play, Elizabeth says that John now has his "goodness." What do you think? Write an essay in which you analyze John Proctor's character, exploring whether or not you think he ultimately is a "good man."

2. How does Reverend Hale's character change throughout the play? Analyze and evaluate the dynamic characterization of Rev. John Hale. Think about the various stages of John Hale's change of character in *The Crucible*.

3. How is the poppet an important symbol in the play? Analyze how the poppet is used as a symbol of Abigail's control.

4. Is there a topic here that you would rather explore? You probably can...just clear it with me!
